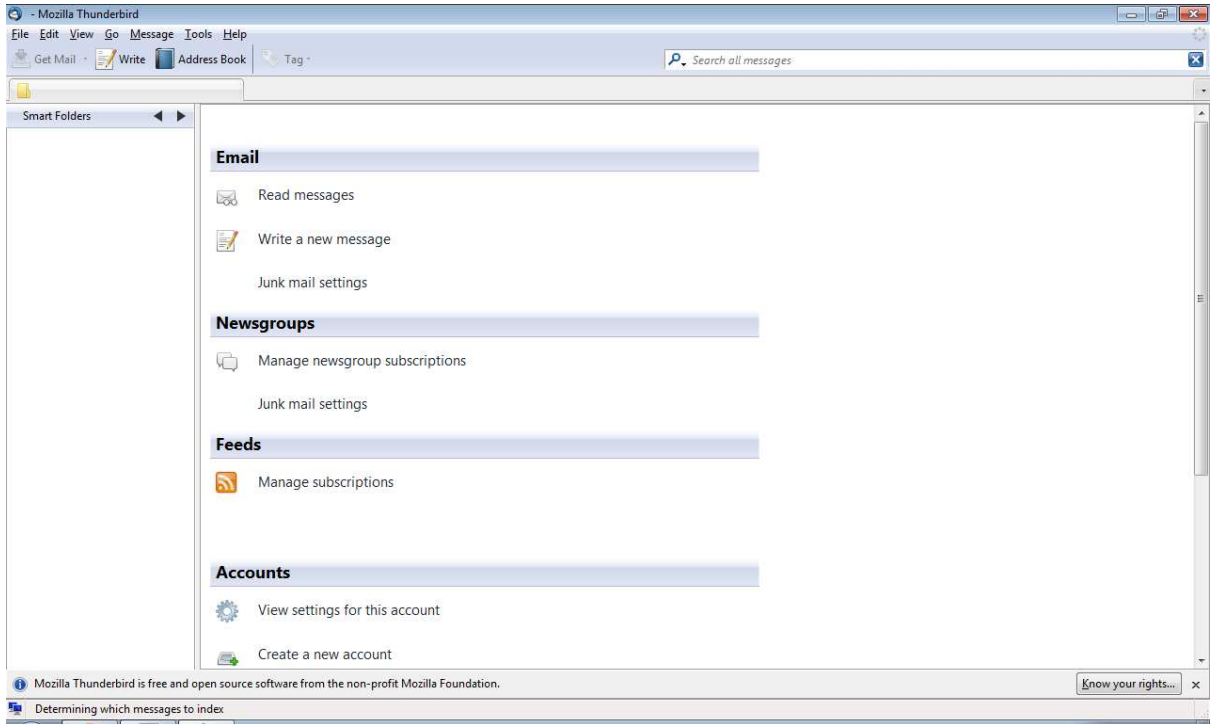

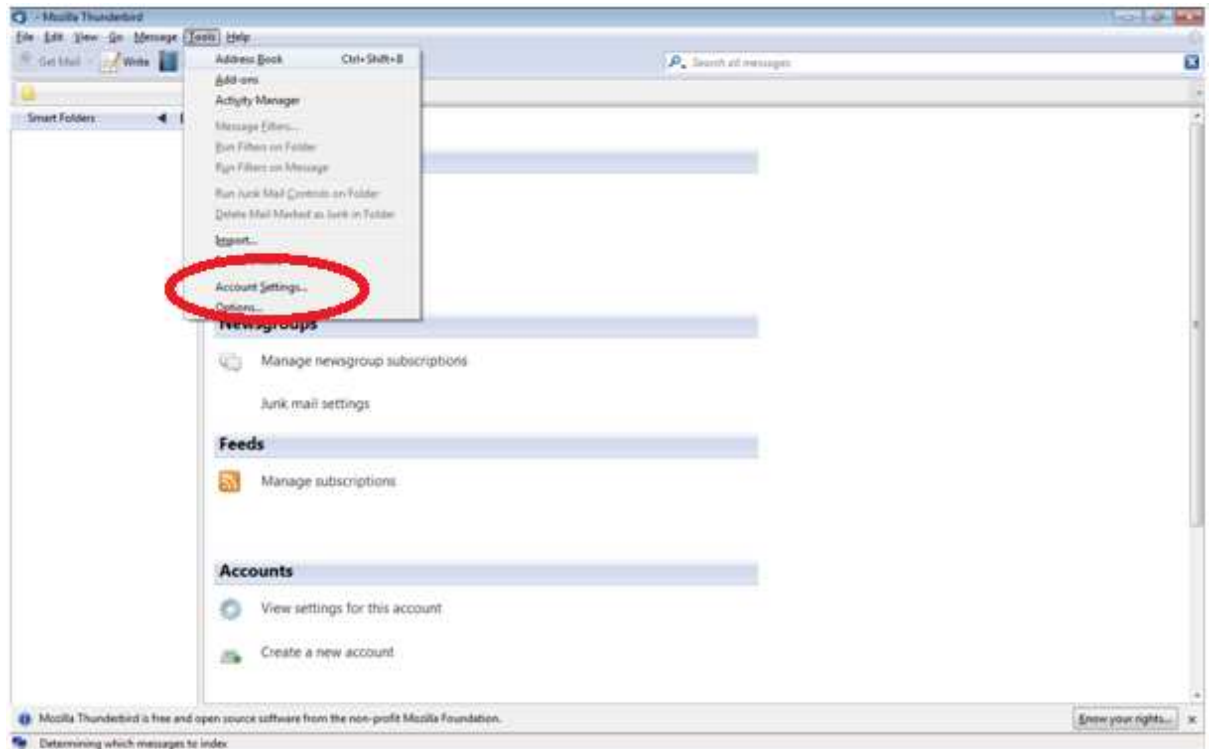

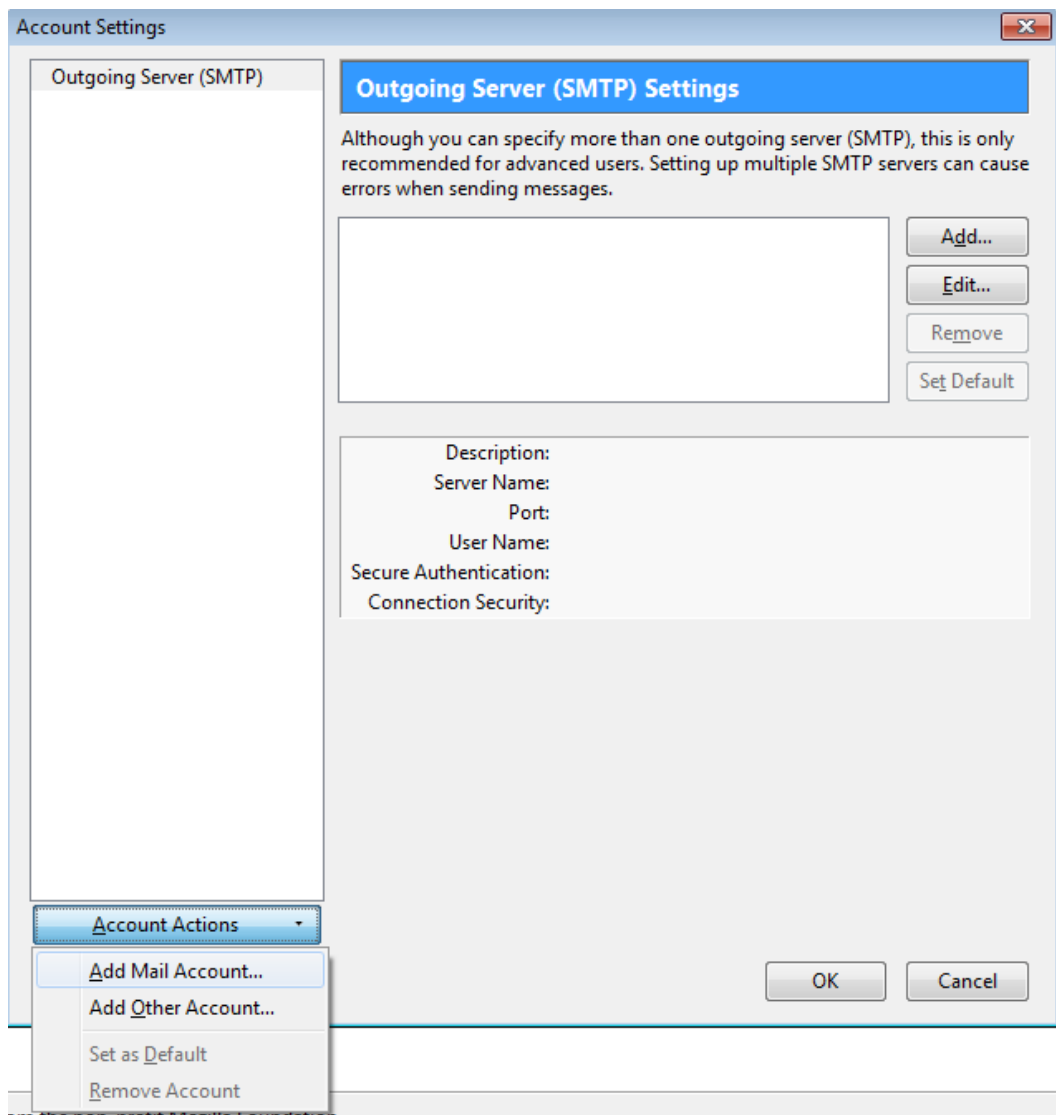
1. Open Thunderbird 3



2. Go to the **Tools** Menu & Select **Account Settings**



- In the bottom Left Hand Side, Click **Account Actions** & select **Add Mail Account**




- Enter the details below & click **Continue**

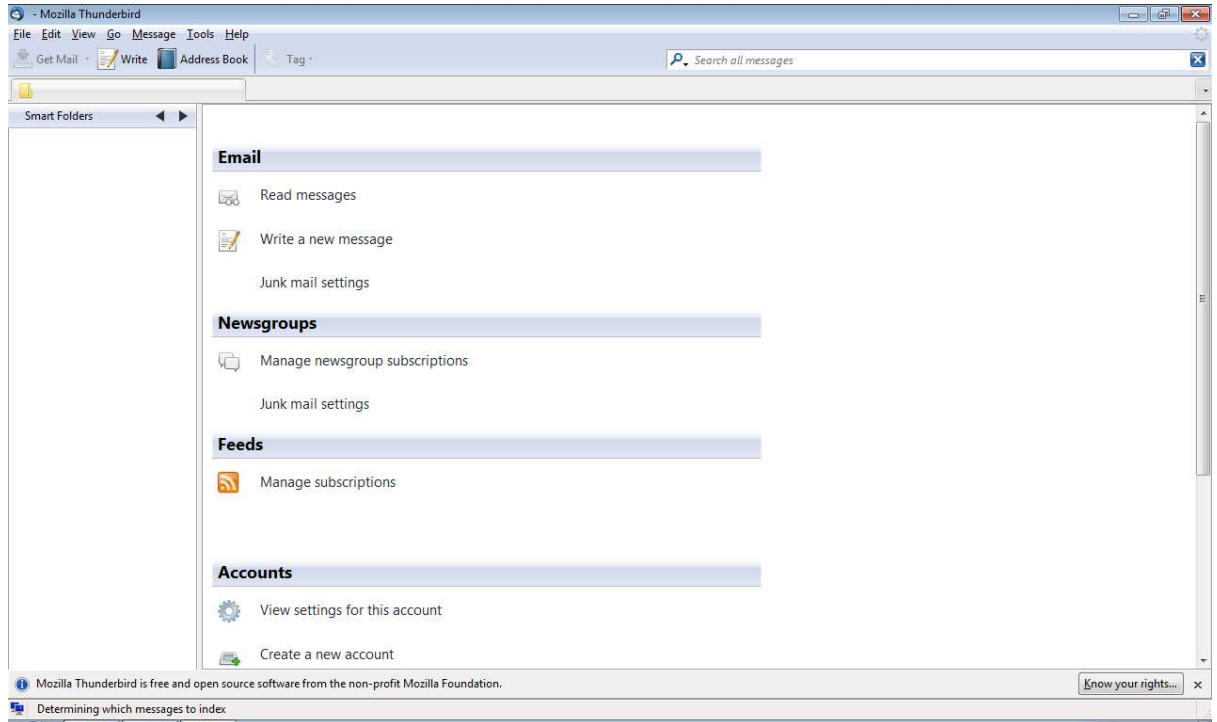
- You will be prompted with a Warning Page. You will need to tick the **I understand the risks** & click **Create Account**.



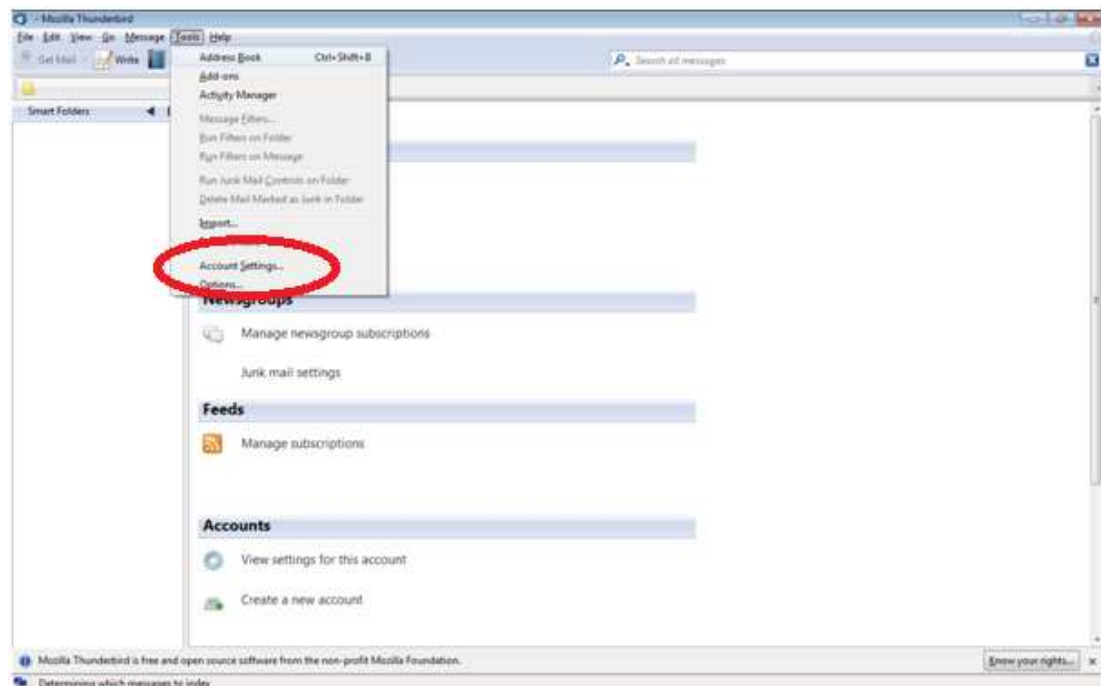
- You will be returned to the previous page, click the **Create Account** button. You have now completed the email setup.

Remove Old Email Account

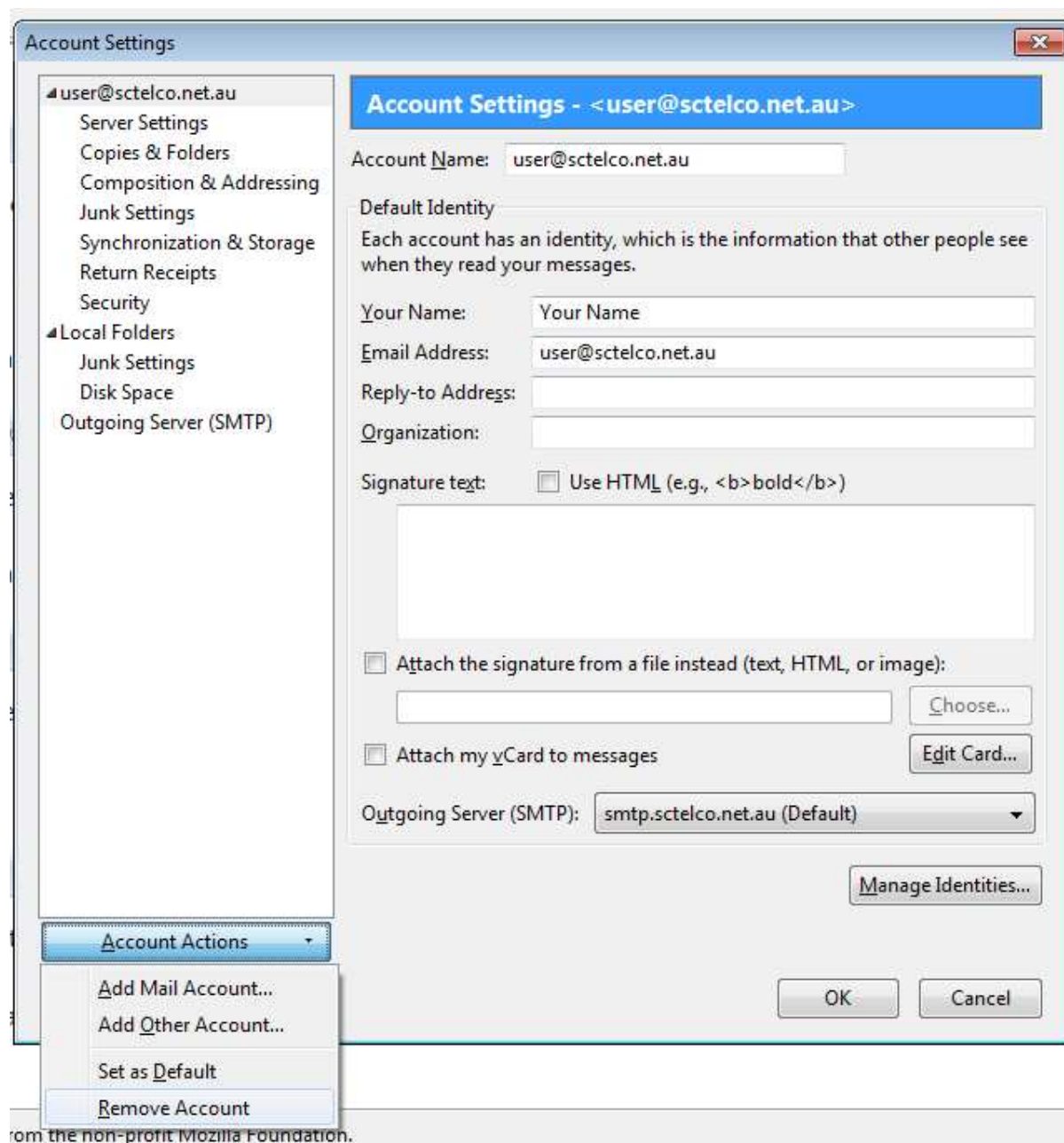
1. Open Thunderbird 3
